

**SENATE BILL No. 330**

1 AN ACT concerning the department of wildlife, parks and tourism;  
2 relating to fees; amending K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the  
3 existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance  
8 with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing  
9 the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following  
10 limitations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and  
11 regulations shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:

12 Big game permits

13 Resident (other than elk permit): maximum \$100

14 Nonresident (other than elk permit): maximum ~~\$400~~\$600

15 Elk permit: maximum ~~\$350~~\$500

16 Nonresident mule deer stamp: maximum ~~\$150~~\$250

17 Nonresident applications: maximum ~~\$25~~\$40

18 Combination hunting and fishing licenses

19 Resident: maximum ~~\$50~~\$100

20 Lifetime: maximum ~~\$1,000~~\$1,500; or 8 quarterly payments, each  
21 maximum ~~\$150~~\$187.50

22 Nonresident: maximum ~~\$200~~\$300

23 Commercial dog training permits: maximum \$25

24 ~~Commercial guide permit or associate guide permit~~

25 ~~Resident: maximum \$250~~

26 ~~Nonresident: maximum \$1,000~~

27 Commercial harvest or dealer permits: maximum \$200

28 Commercial prairie rattlesnake harvesting permits

29 Resident or nonresident with valid hunting license: maximum \$5

30 Resident or nonresident nonfirearm without valid hunting license:  
31 maximum \$20

32 Controlled shooting area operator license: maximum \$400

33 Duplicate licenses, permits, stamps and other issues of the department:  
34 maximum ~~\$10~~\$20

- 33 ~~Resident: maximum \$200~~
- 34 ~~Nonresident: maximum \$1,500~~
- 35 Rabbit permits
- 36 Live trapping: maximum \$200
- 37 Shipping: maximum \$400
- 38 Raptor propagation permits: maximum \$100
- 39 Rehabilitation permits: maximum \$50
- 40 Scientific, educational or exhibition permits: maximum ~~\$10~~\$25
- 41 Wildlife damage control permits: maximum \$10
- 42 Wildlife importation permits: maximum ~~\$10~~\$25
- 43 Wild turkey permits

- 1 Resident: maximum \$100  
2 Nonresident: maximum \$400  
3 Resident turkey tag: maximum ~~\$20~~\$40  
4 Nonresident turkey tag: maximum ~~\$30~~\$60  
5 Special permits under K.S.A. 32-961: maximum \$100  
6 Miscellaneous fees  
7 Special events on department land or water: maximum ~~\$200~~\$500  
8 Special departmental services, materials or supplies: no maximum  
9 Other issues of department: no maximum  
10 Vendor bond: no maximum

12 (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey  
13 hunting permit shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general resident  
14 big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

15 (c) The fee for a big game or wild turkey hunting permit for a resident  
16 under 16 years of age shall be an amount not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a  
17 general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

18 (d) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of  
19 age shall be an amount ~~equal to~~ *not to exceed*  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a resident  
20 furharvester license.

21 (e) For a resident who is at least 65 years of age, but less than 75  
22 years of age:

23 (1) The fee for an annual hunting license shall be an amount equal to  
24  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general annual hunting license;

25 (2) the fee for an annual fishing license shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$   
26 the fee for a general annual fishing license; and

27 (3) the fee for an annual combination hunting and fishing license  
28 shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general annual combination  
29 hunting and fishing license.

30 (f) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in  
31 accordance with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, different fees for  
32 various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances  
33 of the department which may occur within each item as described under  
34 subsection (a).

35 (g) The provisions of subsection (e) shall expire on June 30, 2020.

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.
