2	relating to fees; amending K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
6	Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as
7	follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance
8	with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing
9	the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following
10	limitations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and
11	regulations shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:

13	Resident (other than elk permit): maximum \$100
14	Nonresident (other than elk permit): maximum \$400\$600
15	Elk permit: maximum <del>\$350</del> \$500

12	(b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey
13	hunting permit shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a general resident
14	big game or wild turkey hunting permit.
15	(c) The fee for a big game or wild turkey hunting permit for a resident
16	under 16 years of age shall be an amount not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a
17	general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.
18	(d) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of
19	age shall be an amount equal tonot to exceed 1/2 the fee for a resident
20	furharvester license.
21	(e) For a resident who is at least 65 years of age, but less than 75
22	years of age:
23	(1) The fee for an annual hunting license shall be an amount equal to
24	$1/_2$ the fee for a general annual hunting license;
25	(2) the fee for an annual fishing license shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$
26	the fee for a general annual fishing license; and
27	(3) the fee for an annual combination hunting and fishing license
28	shall be an amount equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the fee for a general annual combination
29	hunting and fishing license.
30	(f) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in
31	accordance with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, different fees for
32	various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances
33	of the department which may occur within each item as described under $r_{\rm exp}$ benefitien (c)
34	subsection (a).
35	(g) The provisions of subsection (e) shall expire on June 30, 2020.
36	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.
37	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
